Gifts from the Heart

Gifts from the Heart help provide the children with necessities for their care and is a great way to support Children in Distress.



Doctors Visit:

Helps provide a child with a visit to the doctor to receive the specialist care needed.

- £22 will cover one week's cost of a child's doctors' Visits.
- £88 will cover one month's cost of a child's doctors' Visits.

Medicine:

Will help provide the medication that is needed to manage a child's medical condition.

- £38 can provide a child with the medication they desperately need for a week.
- £150 can provide a child with the medication they desperately need for a month.





Specialist Therapies:

Will help provide specialist therapies designed to help them with their emotional, social and physical development.

- £75 will provide a child with a week of specialist therapies.
- £300 will provide a child with a month of specialist therapies.



Activities:

Helps provide educational and fun activities for the children to improve their health, wellbeing and development.

£23 can provide a child with a week's worth of activities.

£90 can provide a child with a month's worth of activities.







Meals:

Will help provide 3 meals and snacks to a child specifically designed for their nutritional needs.

£60 will cover the cost of meals and snacks for a child a week.

Thursday, September 26th

The day will commence with a visit to Casa Maria in Bucharest, where we will meet the children in their new home/hospice. Lunch will be provided, offering the chance to converse with both staff and children. In the evening, we are thrilled to host the Charity Heroes Gala Dinner at Bragadiru Palace in Bucharest. The venue is breathtaking and will serve as a fitting backdrop to celebrate and express gratitude to all those who have contributed to the charity's work over the past 35 years.



Friday, September 27th

Our itinerary for Friday includes a journey to Zarnesti, where we'll explore the designated area for the development of Pine View Retreat Lodge—a significant project undertaken by the charity. Here, we'll delve into the vision for its realization and its potential benefits for the local communities.

Following our visit, we'll enjoy lunch in Brasov, a captivating medieval city nestled in the Transylvania region of Romania. Framed by the Carpathian Mountains, Brasov boasts an array of gothic, baroque, and renaissance architecture, offering a picturesque backdrop for our meal.

In the evening, dinner will be provided at a local restaurant in Bucharest.

Saturday, September 28th

We will mark our 35th anniversary with a special service at the Church of the Resurrection in Bucharest, followed by a celebratory lunch.
